1 Three inadequate views of the person of Christ a Apollinarianism (Apollinaris became bishop in Laodicea about AD 361) (1) Christ had a human body only (2) mind and spirit of Christ were from divine nature (3) example: meeting “Mickey Mouse” at Disney World (see Fig 261) (4) Problem: our minds and spirits need salvation too!
